Our Soloists

Hazel Lindsay

Born in Perth, Hazel was educated at Guildtown Primary school and Perth Academy. Her musical training began at the age of four when she started to learn piano and extended to alto saxophone in 1997. She has been extensively involved in several school and central groups and is delighted at last to have the opportunity to play with Perth Youth Orchestra.

Hazel would especially like to thank her tutor Philip Alexander for his guidance, patience and inspiration over the last six years. She is looking forward to studying music further after leaving school in the summer.

The piece which Hazel has chosen to perform is a 20th century piece by the British light music composer Ronald Binge. Movement 2 is a very slow lilting melody which is followed by an exciting Rondo movement which perfectly demonstrates the versatility of the alto saxophone.

Anne Williamson

Anne was born in Bristol in 1986, closely followed by her twin sister, Janet. They were the fourth and fifth children in a musical family. The family moved to Watford when she was three and, at six-and-a-half, she started piano lessons with Mary Ratcliffe. She progressed rapidly through her grades. In 1996, the family moved to Crieff where she now studies with Susan Smart. Anne achieved a distinction in her Grade 8 at age 15. She also played violin and plays clarinet in Perth Youth Orchestra. Anne has been awarded a music scholarship to begin studying music at a university in San Diego, California, this summer. She joins her two older brothers who have both studied there.
